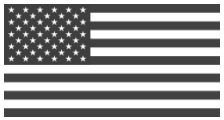

- See displays of military and emergency vehicles dating from the Cold War era (1946 – 1991)
- Meet and view re-enactors and living history groups “re-playing” and describing the era.
- Learn about the tensions fought daily between the “East” and “West” in Berlin and the impact of the creation of the Berlin Wall.
- See Cold War films and documentaries shown throughout both days of the event.
- Listen to Presentations and question-time sessions relating to Cold War operations.
- Learn how close the World came to nuclear conflict during the 1960's and 1980's.

“OBSERVER CORPS SUNDAY” - To mark the 20th year since the initial stand-down of the Royal Observer Corps; the event would like to invite all former Observers to the event for a special ROC day. It is hoped to provide the visitor with:-

- An introduction to the Royal Observer Corps - The organisation of “voluntary” people that would have monitored and assessed the effects of a nuclear attack on the UK.
- An insight into the role of the “Corps” including its links to the R.A.F. and the instruments used for its operations.
- An opportunity to meet with former Observers and listen to their stories.
